Macaulay Child Development Centre is a charitable organization whose mission is to *build a community where children can thrive in caring families and communities*. To achieve this vision, Macaulay offers a continuum of programs and services to children, youth, families and neighbourhoods. Macaulay was established in 1932 and has grown in response to the changing and diverse needs of its community.

Macaulay programs are located in the Western part of Toronto, primarily the former cities of York, North York and Etobicoke. All Macaulay programs include children with special needs; the agency has a special focus on working with children and families living in high need/high risk situations.
